



NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Attention Resident/Business Owner:

Construction will begin in your area soon on the Dixonville project.

Crews will begin to place barricades, mobilize equipment and materials to your area on approximately August 28 th. Safety is our number one priority. You can help us keep the work area safe by obeying all signs and flag persons, and by ensuring everyone in your home and/or business does not enter the work area at any time.

Our goal is to complete the work as efficiently as possible to minimize the disruption.

What area will be affected by construction?

The Project Limits are: 1 St W to Range Road 240, 200 M south of 1 St W, and 2 Ave S, then north 500 M of Highway 689. Please see map below. Please obey all signs, flag persons, crew directions and road closures. Please do not take down or move any barricades, signs or stringline and please do not drive over any tarps or plastic coverings.



Frequently Asked Question:

Who is completing the construction on this project?

Wapiti Gravel Suppliers(Contractor) was awarded this project by the County of Northern Lights (Owner) . The Owner has retained Helix (Engineering Consultant) to manage the project on their behalf. Wapiti Gravel Suppliers may retain several Subcontractors to complete various portions of the work (ie. Asphalt Milling, Landscaping, etc.)

Will I have access during Construction?

While there will be some disruptions, we will try to maintain access for the duration of the project. During some phases of construction (ie. concrete installation) access will be limited and potentially prohibited for a few days. Our crews will give you as much advanced notice as possible.

What hours will the crew be working on this project?

All Construction will fall within the noise bylaw, which permits construction from 7am to 10 pm. Our crews typically try to limit work on Sundays but may need to work if scheduling requires. It is our intent to complete this project in as timely and respectful a manner as possible.

How is may garbage collected during construction?

Please put your garbage and recycling out, as normal on your regular collection day. Our crews will ensure it makes it to the collection truck.

Why is only a portion of my driveway/sidewalk/landscaping being replaced and why is my neighbour getting more of their driveway replaced?

The project has pre-determined limits of construction. While we would like to be able to help you out, we are limited by the Contract, the budget from the owner and the design from the engineer

Can I get additional work done on my Driveway/Sidewalk/Yard while your crew is onsite?

Unfortunately, due to our contractual obligations, limited construction season and busy schedule, this generally does not work out. It is recommended to reach out to our Estimating Department at 780-532-1790. They will be able to confirm and help you out.

I have an irrigation and a buried invisible pet fence.

Please ensure any underground irrigation and buried pet fence is identified, removed or relocated prior to construction.
