

BYLAW #18-11-399

COUNTY OF NORTHERN LIGHTS IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BYLAW FOR THE DELETION OF BYLAW #98-61-056, A BYLAW WHICH WAS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PREVENTING AND COMPELLING THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCE GENERALLY AND REGULATING UNTIDY AND UNSIGHTLY PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PREMISES WITHIN THE DESIGNATED HAMLETS AND WITHIN A HALF MILE RADIUS OF A COUNTRY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY OF NORTHERN LIGHTS AS IDENTIFIED IN THE LAND USE BYLAW.

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 Chapter M-26, and any amendments thereto, empowers a Council of a municipality to:

Section 63 (2) The bylaw may authorize the following (b) omitting and providing for the repeal of a bylaw or a provision of a bylaw that is inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective; and

WHEREAS Council has determined to provide for the elimination of bylaws that have no further need, action, consequence or general application throughout the municipality;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the County of Northern Lights, in the Province of Alberta, pursuant to the terms of the Municipal Government Act, and any amendments thereto,

HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS

PART I: BYLAW TITLE

1. This Bylaw may be cited as the "DELETION OF BYLAW #98-61-056 BYLAW".

PART II: DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

2. In this Bylaw the following definitions shall apply:

a) "Active Records Binder" means the binder(s) that hold all the original, active bylaw relevant to the affairs of the County of Northern Lights, which is kept in a fire proof safe.

b) "Inactive/Repealed Record Binder" means the binder(s) that holds all the original signed repealed bylaws of the County of Northern Lights, which is kept in a fire proof safe.

PART III: APPLICATION

3. The intent of the "Deletion of Bylaw #98-61-056", is to officially repeal Bylaw #98-61-056, cited as the Nuisance Bylaw. Council and the Chief Administrative Officer have deemed Bylaw #98-61-056 to be inoperative, obsolete, expired, spent or otherwise ineffective in the governing of the affairs of the County of Northern Lights.


4. The Nuisance Bylaw #98-61-056 subject matter, *abatement of nuisance generally and regulating untidy and unsightly private and public premises, including remedy, appeal and costs in action*, is covered in the Alberta Municipal Government Act Part 13, Division 4.

5. The Bylaw #98-61-056, upon third and final reading of Bylaw #18-11-399, is hereby repealed/deleted and saved in the Inactive/Repealed binder.


