

**BYLAW NO. 19-11-424**

**BEING A BYLAW OF  
THE COUNTY OF NORTHERN LIGHTS  
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADOPTING COUNTY OF NORTHERN LIGHTS/TOWN OF MANNING INTERMUNICIPAL COLLABORATION FRAMEWORK (ICF), PURSUANT TO THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT, BEING CHAPTER M-26 OF THE STATUTES OF ALBERTA 2000, AND AMENDMENTS THERETO**

**WHEREAS** Section 708.28(1) of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Statutes of Alberta, as amended, mandates that municipalities that have common boundaries must create an Inter-municipal Collaboration Framework with each other that identifies the services provided by each municipality, which services are best provided on an inter-municipal basis, and how services to be provided on an inter-municipal basis will be delivered and funded;

**AND WHEREAS** County of Northern Lights and Town of Manning share a common border;

**AND WHEREAS** County of Northern Lights and Town of Manning share common interest and are desirous of working together to provide services to their residents;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the County of Northern Lights Council, in the Province of Alberta, adopts the County of Northern Lights/Town of Manning Inter-municipal Collaboration Framework, being the document attached hereto and forming part of this Bylaw.

This bylaw comes into force and effect upon third reading by Council.
