

BYLAW NO. 96-32-027

**MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF NORTHERN LIGHTS NO. 22
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**BEING A BYLAW PROVIDING FOR THE CLOSURE AND SALE
OF A CERTAIN PUBLIC ROADWAY WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF
THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF NORTHERN LIGHTS NO. 22.**

WHEREAS the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, Chapter M-26.1 and any amendments thereto, Part 3, Division 2, Section (22), provides that a Municipal Corporation may by bylaw close certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, subject to the approval of the Minister of Transportation and Utilities; and

WHEREAS Transition Agreement #94-06-26-31, effective July 1, 1994 between Alberta Transportation & Utilities and Improvement District No. 22 conveyed responsibility for land contained within certain road plans to the municipality; and

WHEREAS the Municipal District of Northern Lights No. 22, formerly Improvement District No. 22 was formed by Order In Council 260/95 signed by the Lieutenant Governor, effective April 1, 1995; an Order which provided for municipal incorporation and for the transition of Ministerial Orders, Improvement District Orders and Agreements that were in effect prior to March 31, 1995; and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have this roadway closed; and

WHEREAS notice of the intention of Council to pass a bylaw has been given in accordance with Section 606 of the Municipal Government Act; and

WHEREAS the Municipality was not petitioned for an opportunity to be heard by any person or parties claiming to be prejudicially affected by the bylaw; now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Municipal District of Northern Lights No.22, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as "Road Closure Bylaw #003".
2. That, subject to approval from the Minister Responsible for Alberta Transportation & Utilities, the public roadway shown in Schedule "A" [attached] and described as
a 120.70 metre portion of the statutory road allowance forming part of the east boundary of the South East Quarter (SE) of Section Five (5), Township Ninety-one (91), Range Twenty-one (21), West of the Fifth (5th) Meridian, beginning at a point 261.52 metres north of the quarter's southernmost boundary
be closed to public travel, subject to rights of access granted by other legislation.
3. Upon the approval of the Minister of Alberta Transportation & Utilities, and upon the final passage of this Bylaw, the proper officers and officials of the Municipality are hereby authorized and empowered to do all acts necessary or expedient to cause to be issued in the name of the Municipality a certificate of title to the said public roadway

closed pursuant to the provisions of this Bylaw.

4. Upon the approval of the Minister of Alberta Transportation & Utilities, and upon the final passage of this Bylaw, the proper officers and officials of the Municipality are hereby authorized and empowered to execute, on behalf of the Municipality, an agreement for the sale of the said public roadway closed pursuant to the provisions of this Bylaw.

5. This Bylaw shall take effect as and from the third and final reading.


