

BYLAW NO. 96-32-028

MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF NORTHERN LIGHTS NO. 22 IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BYLAW FOR CREATING A TITLE TO AND DISPOSING OF A PORTION OF ROAD ALLOWANCE SURVEYED WITHIN A ROAD PLAN

WHEREAS The Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994, Chapter M-26.1 with amendments thereto, Part 3, Division 2, Section 22 provides that a Municipal Corporation may by bylaw close certain roads, or portions thereof, situated in the said municipality, subject to the approval of the Minister of Transportation and Utilities, and

WHEREAS Transition Agreement #94-06-26-31, effective July 1, 1994 between Alberta Transportation & Utilities and Improvement District No. 22 conveyed responsibility for land contained within certain road plans to the municipality; and

WHEREAS the Municipal District of Northern Lights No. 22, formerly Improvement District No. 22 was formed by Order In Council 260/95 signed by the Lieutenant Governor, effective April 1, 1995; an Order which provided for municipal incorporation and for the transition of Ministerial Orders, Improvement District Orders and Agreements that were in effect prior to March 31, 1995; and

WHEREAS application has been made to Council to have the road allowance, described in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this Bylaw, closed. The Municipal District of Northern Lights No. 22 ("the Municipality") considers it surplus and wishes to sell that portion of the road allowance to the Town of Manning; and

WHEREAS the road allowance not utilized in Road Plan 2344 JY, located between the NE 11-93-23 W5M and NW 12-93-23 W5M is not required for public travel; and

WHEREAS notice of intention to pass this bylaw has been given in accordance with provisions of the said Municipal Government Act; and

WHEREAS no person has claimed to be affected prejudicially by this closure and sale; now

THEREFORE the Council of the Municipal District of Northern Lights No. 22, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be known as the "Road Allowance Closure Bylaw".
2. Subject to the approval of the Minister of Alberta Transportation & Utilities, the road allowance described in Schedule "A", which is attached to and forms part of this Bylaw, is hereby closed.
3. Upon the approval of the Minister of Alberta Transportation & Utilities, and upon the final passage of this Bylaw, the proper officers and officials of the Municipality are hereby authorized and empowered to do all acts necessary or expedient to cause to be issued in the name of the Municipality a certificate of title to the said public roadway closed pursuant to the provisions of this Bylaw.
4. Upon the approval of the Minister of Alberta Transportation & Utilities, and upon the final passage of this Bylaw, the proper officers and officials of the Municipality are hereby authorized and empowered to execute, on behalf of the Municipality, an agreement for the sale of the said road allowance of public roadway closed pursuant to the provisions of this Bylaw.
5. This Bylaw shall have force and take effect as of third and final reading.


