**MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF NORTHERN LIGHTS NO.22
IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA**

**BEING A BYLAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF PLACING DOMESTIC MUSTARD IN THE
RESTRICTED WEED CATEGORY**

WHEREAS the Weed Control Act , Chapter W-6, R.S.A., and amendments thereto, Section (7) provides that the Council of a Municipal District may make bylaws designating plants within the municipality as restricted, noxious or nuisance weeds; and

WHEREAS the Municipal District has deemed it expedient and in the public interest to restrict the spread of domestic mustard seed in and around canola crops within the municipality; now


THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal District of Northern Lights No.22, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That this bylaw may also be known as the "Domestic Mustard Bylaw".
2. That the domestic mustard plant be designated a "restricted weed" of the municipality.
3. That domestic mustard seed, and seed currently defined as: Brown Mustard/Brassica Juncea L., Oriental Mustard/Brassica Juncea L., and Yellow Mustard/Brassica Hirta, also be designated in the municipality's "restricted weed" category.
4. That failure to abide by this bylaw shall result in remedial action and/or penalties imposed utilizing provisions contained in the Weed Control Act.
5. This bylaw shall have force and take effect upon third and final reading.




