The County of Northern Lights
wishes to provide for the extension of services to
allow for growth of Hamlets and Residential areas,
to allow for healthy/ sustainable communities.

The County intends to accomplish this by outlining
a procedure to be followed in an effort to provide or supervise
the extension of sewer services to areas immediately
adjacent to Hamlets with sewer service;
and to determine how costs will be recovered.

PROCEDURE

1. The County will consider requests from residents to connect to a Hamlet sewer system when the following conditions are met:

- The property to be serviced abuts to the Hamlet boundary
- The length of line (distance) required to service the property is no more than 200 meters
- The property owner shall be responsible for all costs to hire a contractor and install the line to the County's standards.
- All required permits shall be obtained by the resident or contractor on behalf of the resident
- Any creek crossings shall be required to have the required permits to cross over or bore under the crossing.
- Upon completion and inspection, the line shall become the property of the County and the County will be responsible to maintain the line up to the curb cock (CC)

2. All sewer services within a Hamlet's boundaries shall be subject to local improvement charges.

3. County utilities staff shall be on site and ensure services are installed to County standards.

4. Resident is responsible to apply for an account through the County office and shall be charged the same fees as applicable within the Hamlet.
